PURPOSE

The Henry Lee Riley Memorial Scholarship was established by the family of Henry Lee Riley .

Henry Lee Riley is a McAdams High School Class of 1977 and Coahoma Community College Class of 1979 graduate. He owned, Henry Riley's Air conditioning and Refrigeration where he served his community through repairing appliances. Affectionately known as Sipe, Henry was an avid fisherman and hunter.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Henry Lee Riley Memorial _____ Scholarship Fund will make available a scholarship to a qualified candidate who will attend or is attending a Mississippi accredited two and/or four year college or university, with plans to pursue a degree.

CRITERIA

In making a decision, the Scholarship Advisory Committee will use the following criteria:

- Acceptance to a Mississippi accredited college or university
- Recommendation Letters
- Extracurricular Curricular Activities (Optional)

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be a US citizen, a high school senior from McAdams High School who is graduating with the current graduating class.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale and must provide an official transcript in a sealed envelope from the high school currently attending that includes the first semester of senior year.
- Must register as a full-time student within the next 6 months following date of graduation at any Mississippi junior college, community college, or university. (Note: Proof of enrollment must be provided before funds are distributed.)
- Attach 3 letters of recommendation from the following individuals:



- Any other non-family adult of the student's choosing (i.e. teacher, guidance counselor, leader of community organization, boss, religious leader)

NOTIFICATION

Applicants will be notified by mail about the status of their application no later than May 1. Scholarship funds will be distributed directly to the institution of the applicant's choice no later than August 15.

GUIDELINES

Each complete application must be received by the Community Foundation by March 1.

- Official high school transcripts
- Copy of ACT or SAT score
